My husband & I visited the liquidation sale@ the Allen County Fairgrounds Friday 2-17-12. We heard the advertisement on Lite Rock 107.1
I wanted to let you know how very disappointing this event was. On the advertisement they spoke specifically about televisions & many other electronic items for sale. There **NO** Televisions, drills, dvd players etc (these were all mentioned & many others items on the radio that were not there for sale) . The tv's they had (possibly 10 or 12 boxes & now I'm not sure they had TV's in them) were in a booth where somehow you paid to play a game similar to a carnival game to try to win one of the tv's (at least this is what we were told by a woman working in a booth beside the tv booth). The booth was unmanned @ 6pm Friday nite. The woman said they had already gone for the nite! SO we werent able to talk to whoever was supposed to be there. We felt like this was an **extremely misleading advertisement**. It also cost us \$14 to enter the building which was no more than a very poorly put together flea market. There were numerous people in the brief time we stayed that were also very upset. Some were smarter than we as they refused pay the entry fee. You may be contacted by other frustrated consumers.
Don't think I have ever felt this frustrated about being misled. I wasn't really sure who to contact but saw that you may have something to do with selling advertisements & if you would pick this up prior to Monday you may want to check out the radio advertisement & what is actually going on at the "SALE".
